The Press Intern will work under the campaign's Press Secretary and the rest of the communications team on a range of day-to-day press operations. Responsibilities will include, but are not limited to:

- Creating and maintaining press lists and media contacts
- Conducting daily media monitoring and tracking relevant coverage
- Supporting the drafting of press statements, social media copy, talking points, and other written materials
- Assisting with press outreach and other communications projects as needed

Candidates should have availability to work at least 15 hours per week, with scheduling flexibility to accommodate classes and other extracurricular commitments. Proximity to Louisville is preferred, but not required.
